


2. Description of Symptom and Improvement

Customers may complain about the following symptom. A countermeasure to eliminate the symptom has been set up. Its contents are as follows.

Symptom	Details of Symptom and Improvement
On some certain vehicles, the side view of the front bumper may come loose.	Details of Symptom, Cause: The side part of the front bumper may come loose. This is because the claw of the front bumper rubs against the bracket corner and damages it, resulting in the poor fitting force.
	Improvement Content: Please install the PLATE BMPR SD (metal plate), which has been newly set as a reinforcing part, to reinforce the affected area. For the working procedure, please refer to this service bulletin.

5. Working Procedure


Remove the front bumper.

For the removing procedure, please refer to the service manuals.


- Judge whether the front bumper is reusable or not.
- "Judgment Criteria"

The front bumper that satisfies the following conditions is judged to be reusable.


- There is no crack, whitening or damage (excluding damage of the claw fitting part due to the rubbing) on the affected area.
- · There is no deformation on the claw fitting part. (Refer to View C)
- · The dimension is within the reference value range (4.5 mm or less). (Refer to Section E-E)





- 3. Rinse off the dirt on the affected area of the front bumper with water.
- Apply neutral detergent between the flange parts of the PLATE BMPR SD.



5. Install the PLATE BMPR SD on the back face (RH, LH) of the front bumper.



NOTE:

If there is a burr on the front bumper and it is difficult to install the PLATE BMPR SD, remove the burr on the front bumper using a metal file, etc. Be careful not to file other parts than the burr.

6. Install the front bumper.

For the installation procedure, refer to the service manuals.

Be careful: the PLATE BMPR SD may come off if it contacts the peripheral parts multiple times at the installation.

- Visually confirm that the PLATE BMPR SD is installed from the gap of the side splitting part of the front bumper.
- Rinse off the neutral detergent applied to PLATE BMPR SDS by pouring water onto the side splitting part of the front bumper.

CAUTION:

Take care the edge of the PLATE BMPR SD that is sharp edge.

Procedure in the Service Manual is not changed, also the tightening torque is not changed.

6. Labour Time

In case of Front bumper is reused: 0.5 h
In case of Front bumper is replaced: 0.8 h
